A highlight for me recently was to attend the introduction into the House of Assembly of the amended Bill to decriminalise sex work. Ten Zontians from six clubs were invited to sit in the Speakers Gallery as the guest of Deputy Premier and Attorney General Vicky Chapman. This was a wonderful display of bipartisan advocacy. Hon. Tammy Franks had already introduced the Bill in the Legislative Council, which a few of us also attended. This time Hon. Vicky Chapman (Liberal) and Katrina Hildegard (Labor MP for Reynella and a Zontian) spoke to the Bill. Afterwards they invited us to morning tea in the Banquet Room, along with representatives of the Sex Industry Network and lawyers. Other MPs, including Heysen Liberal MP Josh Teague and Labor Nat Cook also joined us. The Bill will be debated on 25th September. Watch out for the interesting media articles!

It is not too late to book for the Districts Conference from 6th to 8th September. There will be over 200 Zontians from our District alone. A great turn out, with lots of fun! Why not join us, registration is open until 31st August.


