This month we note that the gender pay gap has remained unchanged since last year. Perhaps we should call it [Un]Equal Pay Day!

Equal Pay Day in Australia - 28 August 2020

This year, [Un]Equal Pay Day is on 28 August 2020, marking the 59 additional days from the end of the previous financial year that women must work, on average, to earn the same amount as men earned that year. The Workplace Gender Equality Agency (WGEA) has calculated the national gender pay gap remains stable at 14% (for full-time employees). This is a difference of \$253.60 per week.

UN International Equal Pay Day – 18 September 2020

This year, for the first time The United Nations has deemed 18 September to be International Equal Pay Day. The UN believes that the International Days are a powerful Advocacy tool to raise global awareness and the International Equal Pay Day will highlight the gender pay gap. Women are estimated to receive an average of 20% less pay than men, globally, for equal work.

The international community has made a commitment to gender equality in the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development and specifically in Goals 5 and 8.5.

The Equal Pay International Coalition (EPIC) is currently the only multi-stakeholder partnership working to reduce the gender pay gap at the global, regional and national levels. It is led by the UN Women, the International Labour Organisation and OPEC. https://www.un.org/en/observances/equal-pay-day
