## Zonta Club of Kathmandu provides bicycles to girls to decrease school dropout rates

In far-flung areas of southern Nepal, school dropout from high among girls from ages 12 to 16. One reason is that most of the villages have only primary schools. For middle school, students must travel to a nearby village, which at times leads to girls dropping out. Dropping out of school can lead to early marriage, pregnancy and other health-related issues.



Realizing the need and importance of education for these young girls, the Zonta Club of Kathmandu teamed up with Teach for Nepal. They identified 50 girls with a crucial need for bicycles. The bicycles allow the girls to continue their schooling and feel empowered by owning their own bicycles.
