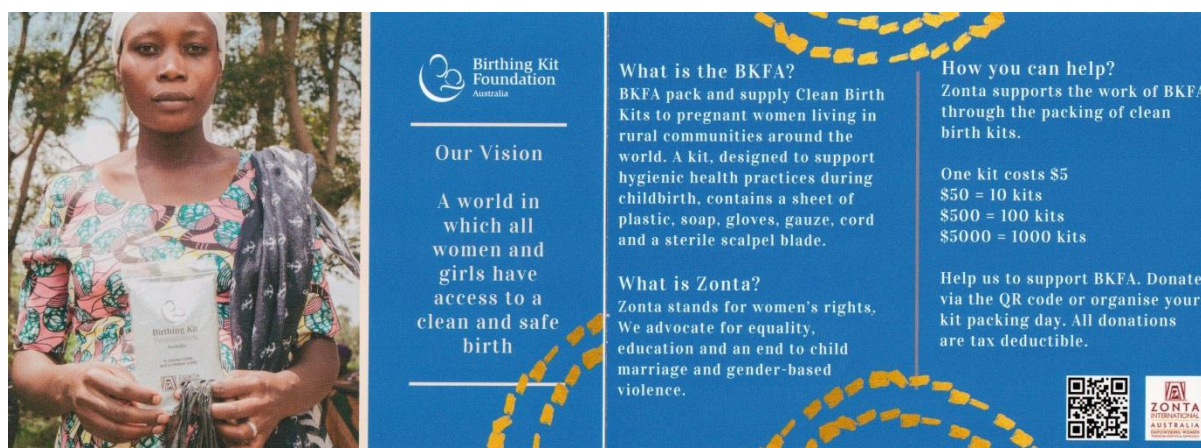
For us all, the fact that lives are being saved, and that communities in developing countries are still complete with mothers giving a safe clean birth to their new-born babies, is what drives us.
