

A message from our Government Partner, the Australian Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade

In February 2023, the Minister for Foreign Affairs, Senator the Hon Penny Wong, announced that Australia will develop a new international gender equality strategy. For example, Australia's E-commerce Aid for Trade Fund supported 11 e-commerce capacity building projects in developing and least developed countries across Southeast Asia and the Pacific. Over 850 micro, small and medium-sized enterprises increased their specialised e-commerce skills, and over 50 per cent of beneficiaries were women.
