Dinner Meeting held Wednesday 22nd March 2023



We were given a presentation from Deb Hosking. Deb is the co-founder and an Executive Manager of the Project Green Group of Companies, including Austral Tree Solutions, Project Green and Wood for Good, a social enterprise. Deb is the trustee of the Hosking Foundation and serves as the Chair on the Board of World Relief Australia, overseeing international sustainable development.

Deb is the National Ambassador for Bright Futures where she established the "Uniting Dynamic Women" initiative, empowering underprivileged women in Nairobi's slums. This initiative was the subject of her presentation at the meeting.

Deb started her presentation with a video of a young woman who had run away to avoid being married at a young age, and through life circumstances, had given birth to a child with cerebral palsy and been abandoned by her family. In the depths of her despair with no food and unwell she felt her only solution would be to kill her child to survive. Fortunately, this did not occur due to the intervention of the Bright Futures program representatives.

The remainder of Deb's presentation outlined stories relating to 3 key take aways from the program and her time in Kenya, when they visited last year.


The 3 key takeaways were:

- The depth of gratitude, as opposed to thankfulness of students, particularly girls who were receiving an education and meals while at school.
- The resilience of women living in housing the size of tool sheds, walking up to 7 kms every week, carrying a child requiring physiotherapy, all while rejected and unsupported by their families.
- The empowerment and wisdom of the women, psychologically, emotionally and gaining an education.

The stories shared the success of the program in helping women find their vision and gain their financial independence, in a community that had abandoned them through the circumstances they found themselves in.

One woman who had found her vision started a school in her small accommodation with just two children, growing to seven by the end of the week. Now within five years, a school has been created, including reception to year 12 and the children go home and teach their parents.
