**Location:** Blackwood Baptist Church Hall, 72 Coromandel Parade, Blackwood.

Bring with you: Your sewing machine/overlocker, scissors etc. If your machine has not been electrically tested in the last 12 months, we will have someone available between 9.30 am until 10.30 am to test it for you.

Pre-cut fabric and instructions will be supplied.

Cost: There is no cost to attend, however we can always use donations of new, good quality knickers in girls sizes 10-12, 12-14 or 14-16 (flowers, vivid designs or solid colours are best). NO white writing, animals, cartoons or glam). Also, new face washers and good quality, 100% cotton fabric and flannelette are always appreciated but please check with the Days for Girls co-ordinators for further guidelines before purchasing fabric (all fabric will need to be washed prior to sewing).

Want to come along and help, but can't sew a stitch? There is plenty you can do threading cord in bags, folding liners, making labels, packing bags, pressing, trimming and cutting fabric, etc.

## BREAST CANCER TRAINING IN SRI LANKA

## Breast Cancer training in Sri Lanka.

A collaborative project between Zonta Club of Colombo11 (District 25) and Zonta Club of Botany Bay (District 24) arranged a workshop to train nurses in specialist breast cancer detection and treatment.

With very little mammography available in Sri Lanka, the importance of early detection and recognition of breast cancer by self examination became vital.

Ann Selle OAM led the team of trainers to deliver the first workshop to the nurses from all 11 provinces of Sri Lanka. Post course evaluation strongly indicated that additional training is required. The first workshop was funded by members of Zonta Club of Botany Bay and friends. However the reality is that we now have to extend our fundraising base to ensure early detection of breast cancer for Sri Lankan women becomes a reality.

This project is one that can have an immediate and long term effect on the lives of many women and brings together our Clubs and Districts at an international level.
